Wine mixed with myrrh...

Holy anointing oil (for holy purposes ONLY) – Exodus 30:23-37

Gambling to see what each would get...

III. We see the clearly _____ (Mark 15:26-27)

Luke 23:39-43

“He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To the one who conquers I will grant to eat of the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God” (Revelation 2:7).

What have you done with Jesus? What are you doing with Jesus?

IV. We see the foolishly _____ (Mark 15:29-32).

Derided, mocked, reviled!

Their messages are always the same:

- Save yourself, worship yourself
- God, do what I want, and I'll see and believe

“Repent and believe in the gospel.”
